After hearing about Boomerang Bags, a group of Shelburne residents, led by Pat Chute, got together with sewing machines, sergers, irons, and yards of donated fabric to start creating reusable bags for residents in the Town of Shelburne.

The initial order of 260 generically made labels finally arrived and were quickly sewn onto their recently made Boomerang Bags. Since then the group has raised enough money through cash donations to order 3000 labels which indicated, their Boomerang Bag was “Sustainably Sewn in Shelburne, NS”.



The groups’ goal is to supply people (business operators and individuals), with cloth shopping bags and to educate our citizens with respect to the environmental issues pertaining to single use plastics.
